The Euroculture Programme offers you:

- » An interdisciplinary approach involving the disciplines of Cultural Studies, History, Political Science, International Relations, Theology, Philology and Literature.
- » An international joint degree-programme within a consortium of eight European and four non-European universities.
- » A well-established mobility scheme in order to study at two or more different universities within the consortium.
- » The possibility to study at the renowned University of Göttingen and other top-ranked universities.
- » The chance to study in an international environment and to experience other languages, perspectives and cultural practices.
- » The opportunity to partake in an international summer school with over a hundred participants from all partner universities.
- » Erasmus Mundus scholarships will be offered to a number of students.

Studying Euroculture in Göttingen means:

- » A four-semester Master Programme (120 ECTS).
- » Researching into European cultures and institutions in more specific terms (First semester in Göttingen).
- » Gaining a broader perspective of »Europe in the Wider World« (Second semester at one of our European partner universities).
- » Taking part in an international summer school of about ten days. The location of the event alternates between the partner universities. (Between the second and third Euroculture semesters).
- » To either take a professional or a research track. During the latter you deepen your research skills and theoretical knowledge (European-/Non-European university). During the professional track you do an internship in order to acquire relevant professional skills and competences (Third semester).
- » A colloquium and further supervision in working on the Master Thesis (Fourth semester in Göttingen).
